Prizes for Overall Youth Champion & Reserve Champion High Point (both youth divisions will be combined for these awards).

2 YR OLD RANCH HORSE CHALLENGE classes will begin after the lunch break – classes that make up the challenge are: Ranch Penning, Ranch Riding, Ranch Trail, & Ranch Conformation. There will be 2 divisions – Open & Non-Pro. Money added and 50% payback of entries. Pre-Entry fee is \$50, entries must be received by Sept 1st. Entries received between Sept 1st & day of show is \$100. Rider & Owner must be a member of KRHA. All entries must include proof of ownership & age of horse – registration papers or vet certificate will be accepted.

No Refunds. Judge's decision is Final.

Out of State Horses are required to have coggins & health papers.

THERE WILL BE A 30 MIN. LUNCH BREAK – time will be announced. Concessions on grounds.

ORDER OF CLASSES SUBJECT TO CHANGE.

All dogs must be on a leash. No alcohol allowed on premises.

Long sleeve western shirt, jeans, & western hat required. No excessive silver or neon. No banded manes, tail extensions, or hoof polish. Riding helmets are allowed.
